SPECTATOR BEHAVIOR

The following is to explain the specific league policies and rules concerning acceptable behavior and unacceptable behavior of all spectators at all practices/games throughout the sport season.

This policy is to protect the integrity of our children's Youth Sports Program.

In order to ensure that ALL PLAYERS are protected parents/guardians and their friends will be accountable for his/her own behavior at all practices/games. Parents and their friends will also be accountable for their children's and teenager's behavior and actions.

The following is acknowledgement of parents/guardians understanding of responsibilities as stated by these rules and policies. Failure to comply will result in immediate expulsion from the NAO Complex of the Violator.

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

1. Consumption of alcoholic beverages at games and practices is prohibited.
2. Cheering is encouraged but should not be foul language nor should it provoke foul language and/or behavior.
3. Profane language is unacceptable at all times
4. Harassing or "name calling the umpires, opposing team players, coaches, and spectators WILL NOT be tolerated. This only breeds trouble.
5. Cooperation with Team Representatives and league officials is expected of all parents/guardians.
6. An uncontrollable outburst directed toward anyone is unacceptable. All disputes should be petitioned through the proper channels.
7. If opposing team's spectators violate the rules, it doesn't entitle you to the same. Remember we are in the public eye. Please set a good example for our children.
8. Parents/guardians will exhibit and promote good sportsmanship at all times to the best of their ability.

This document must be read and signed by all player's parents/guardians who may at anytime participate or watch any practice or game through the season and must be signed prior to player participation in any and all league games.
